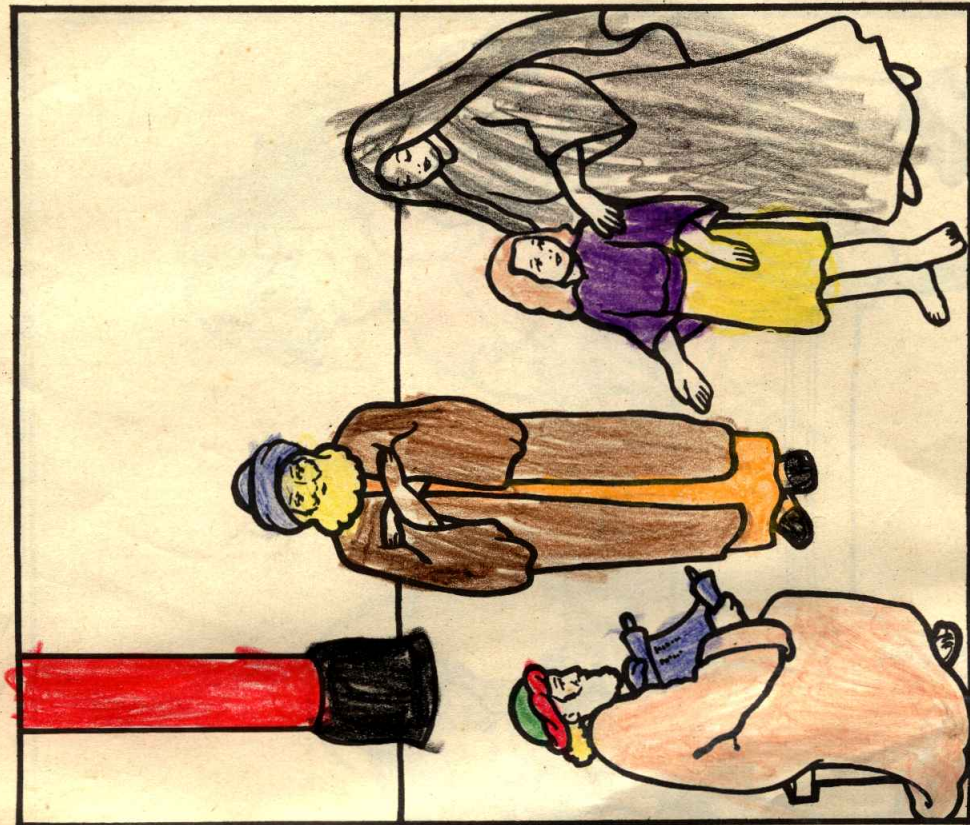


14. THE BOY JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

Home of Jesus

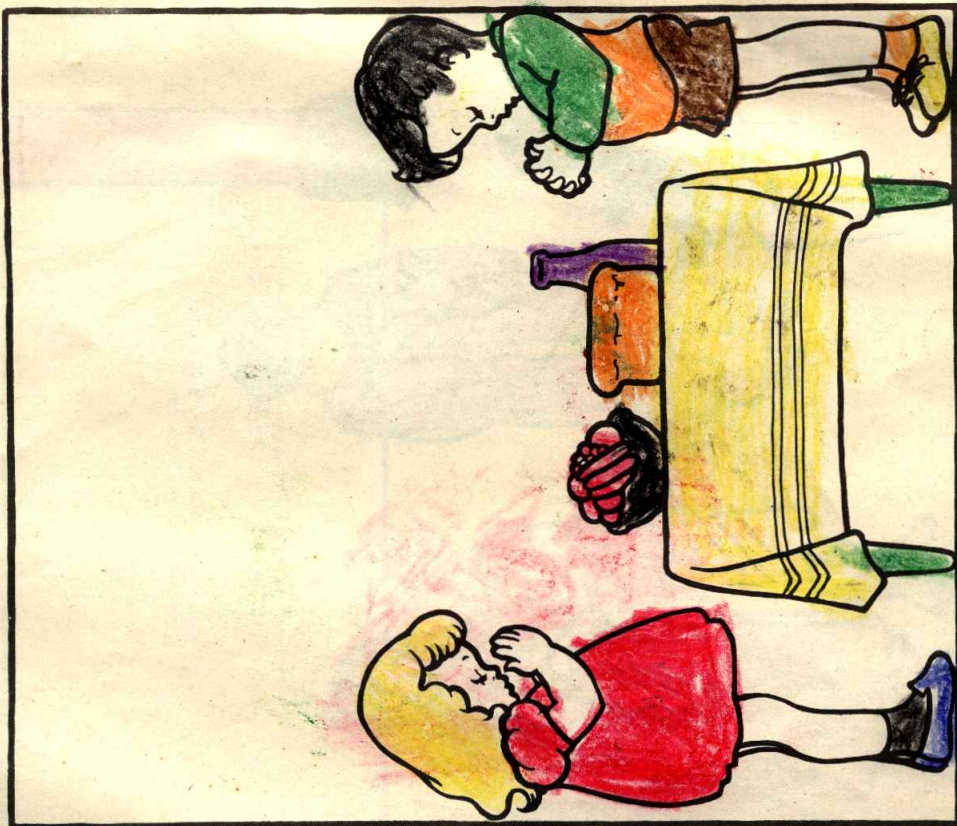

—Luke 10: 25-37

—Matthew 8: 5-13.

—Mark 7: 31-37.

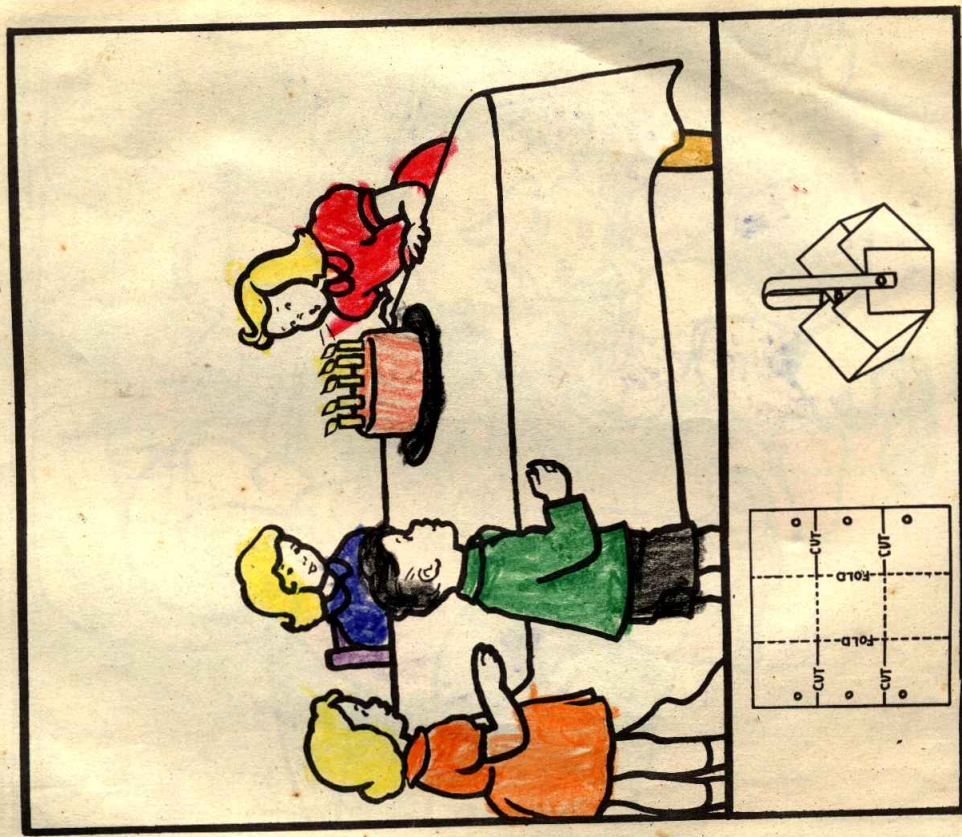

Review Texts.

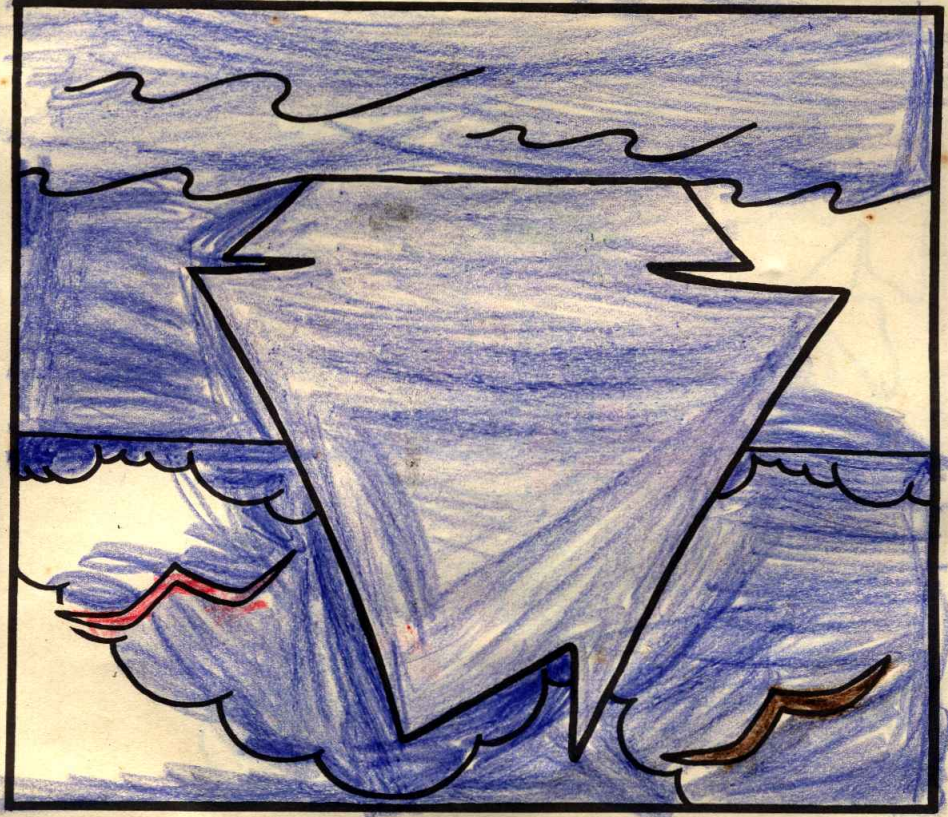

—Mark 4:35-41.

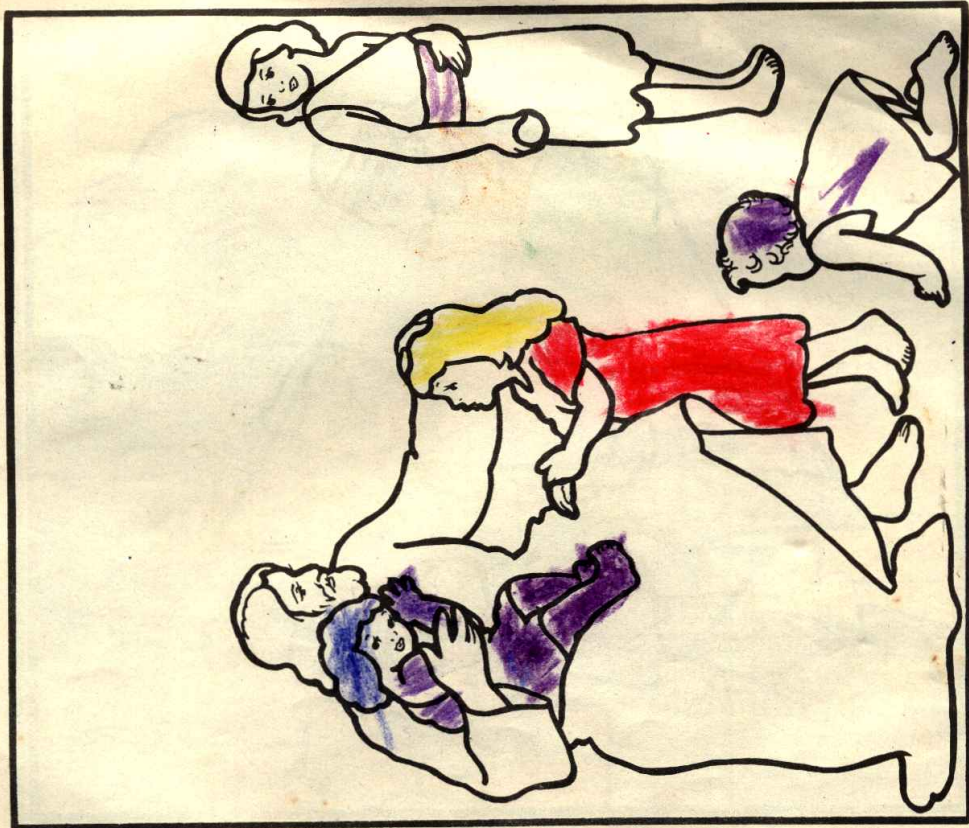

—Matthew 21: 1-16.

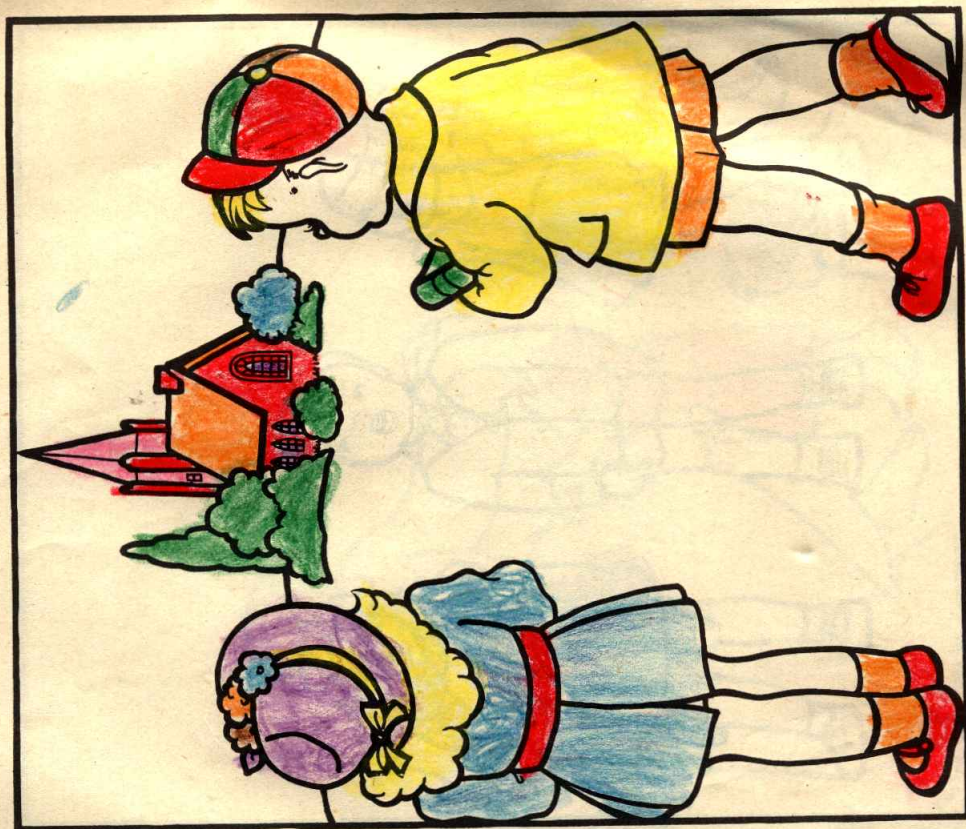


Because Jesus loved and blessed them, the children wanted to show Jesus how much they loved Him. They brought flowers and palms to throw in His path as He came into the city. They praised and thanked God for sending His Son, Jesus, to be their friend.

"Praise the name of the Lord."—Joel 2: 26b.

25. HOW WE MAY BE JESUS' FRIENDS

—Luke 22: 7-23.



Do you hear the church bell when it rings? It tells us to come to church. This little boy and girl heard it and they are on their way to Sunday school. There they will hear stories about Jesus and remember that He is a kind friend.
